Midwest Barber college signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution used 100 percent of all HEERF III funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to our Students.

A total of \$4,874.00 was disbursed to 19 Students at the institution. 19 Students received grants of \$256.53. For students to be determined eligible to receive grants under this program students must first be determined to be making satisfactory academic progress (SAP). The amount of aid was evenly distributed amongst all eligible students.
